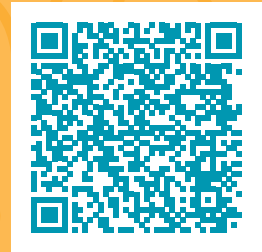

Not sure where to start? Try our Highlights Tour

This simple route will guide you to some of our top picks, for a quick but solid foundation in Melbourne's Greek-influenced architecture.

Start at the **Hellenic Museum**

Walk, catch a La Trobe Street tram or City Loop train to **State Library Victoria**

Walk to **Trades Hall** (optional: visit **Emily McPherson College** along the way!)

Walk to **Parliament House** (optional: visit the **Royal College of Surgeons** along the way!)

Walk or catch a Bourke Street tram to **GPO**

Walk to Swanston Street and catch a tram to the **Shrine of Remembrance**
